Rules:

1. Must provide your own grill, tent, table, and any other equipment you will need. (Grills cannot be directly under tents, and please bring a carpet or mat to place under grill to catch grease)
2. We will provide power, 15 amps per team.
3. Three Categories with 4 total prizes:
 - a. Best Pork Belly Burnt Ends – Winner announced on Friday (8pm)
 - b. Best Pulled Pork – Winner announced on Saturday (7pm)
 - c. People’s Choice – Winner announced on Saturday (7:30pm)
 - d. Best Overall – Winner announced on Saturday (7:45pm)

• **Registration and entry fee must be received no later than Friday, June 23, 2023.** The event organizer will contact you to plan for site set-up time at The Community Park. No grills or set-up will be allowed prior to the designated check-in and set-up time.

• **Set-up:** will take place between 9am – 2pm on Friday, July 14th, 2023. Competitor site inspections will begin at 3pm on that day (Friday). **All contestants must be set up and ready to cook by as early as 4 pm and prepared for inspection.** Grillers are allowed to start/cook any time after inspection on Friday and until cooking end time as scheduled below:

- o Pork Belly Burnt Ends – Food turn-in, Friday 7pm (Trophy & \$250 Cash Prize)
- o Pulled Pork – Food turn-in, Saturday 6pm (Trophy & \$250 Cash Prize)
- o People’s Choice – Open to public: Friday at 7pm & Saturday 6pm (Trophy & \$250 Cash Prize)
- o Best Overall – Saturday 7:45pm (Trophy & \$500 Cash Prize)

• Each griller must submit up-to 15 samples for judges (subject to change based on number of judges; you will be informed by June 30th on number of judges); event organizers will supply containers. **JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**
